

LOGIC FLOW OUTLINE FOR DEVELOPING CACS

1. Start:

- Identify whether your query relates to FSMDT Requirements or NCA Accreditation Standards.

2. FSMDT Requirements:

- **Topics Include:** Protocols for collaboration, reporting procedures, interagency agreements, confidentiality requirements, and child safety protocols.

- **Contact:**

- **Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth (OCCY)**
 - Oversees FSMDT compliance under Oklahoma Administrative Code 135:10-25.

3. NCA Accreditation Standards:

- **Topics Include:** Adherence to NCA’s accreditation pillars, including organizational governance, direct service requirements, facility standards, and adherence to NCA’s best practice policies.
